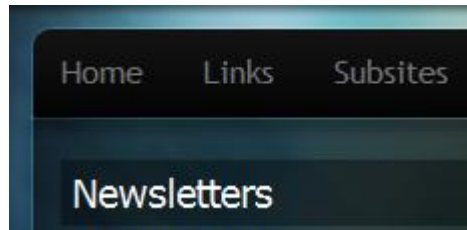

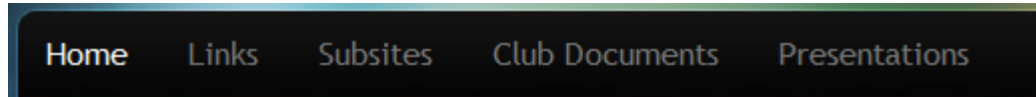
Changing Display Size

All modern browsers allow you to change the size of what is being displayed – the simplest method is

- `<ctrl> +` to make it larger
- `<ctrl> -` to make it smaller
- `<ctrl> 0` to restore it to original size

You can also choose to resize only the text, how that is done depends on the browser.

The Top Navigation



Navigation to other parts of the site including members only areas, SIG sites, and possibly members sites (more on this later in the presentation).

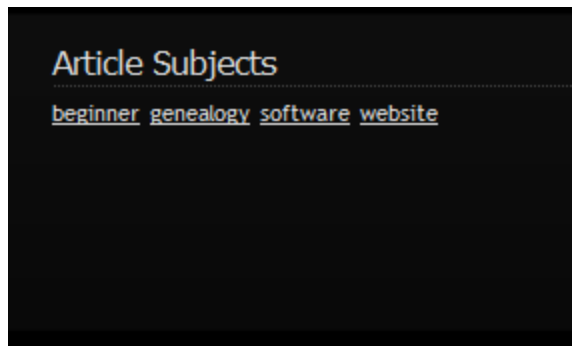
These are all dropdown menus, click on them to see the options.

Other Navigation Bars

Slide Show Controls

By the way, the slideshows play by themselves by default, but if you want to control the way the pictures change, simply hover over them.
